On Saturday, June 19, 2010, Julian Abele Park will be turned into an open air craft fair / flea market / bazaar.

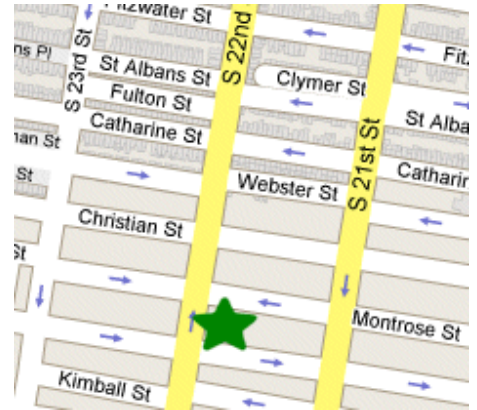
We are currently seeking vendors.
